



Concerned about the religious faith and material welfare of immigrant families, Father McGivney founded the Knights of Columbus with the help of several men of St. Mary's Parish in New Haven, Connecticut in 1882. Its purpose was to help strengthen the faith of the men of his parish and to provide financial assistance in the event of their death to the widows and orphans they left behind. He was known for his tireless work among his parishioners.

On March 15, 2008, Pope Benedict XIV approved a decree recognizing the heroic virtue of Fr. Michael J. McGivney, founder of the Knights of Columbus, giving the parish priest the distinction of "Venerable Servant of God." On October 31, 2020, Pope Francis declared Fr. McGivney "blessed." He is now one step from canonization as a saint. If canonized, Fr. McGivney would be the first American born priest to be so honored.

The Knights of Columbus have over 2 million members worldwide. From the moment of our founding in 1882, charity has been the first principle of the Knights of Columbus. We are men of faith and men of action.

Last year alone, in addition to raising and donating more than \$150 million to charitable needs and projects, Knights volunteered more than 47 million hours of their time to charitable causes. We undertake these acts of charity because we see those in need through the eyes of faith. Moreover, in the Knights of Columbus, we approach these acts of charity together. Pope Benedict XVI called this the "practice of love...as a community."

Eligibility Requirements:

- 1. Graduating high school senior in 2022
- 2. Active and Registered member (or family) of Emmaus Catholic Parish
- 3. Actively pursuing the continuation of education through an accredited college, university or trade/technical school

We will award **three \$2,500 scholarships overall**; one \$2,500 scholarship to each of the top three selected eligible students.
